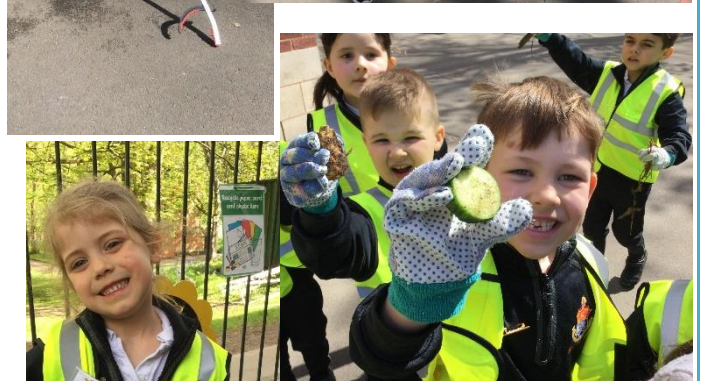
Year 2 Trip to Eureka
