Chapter 3

In Year 3, we have been developing our letter writing skills further by including more questions in our responses to pen pals. We have continued practising the songs for Young Voices, and the excitement is beginning to build. On Wednesday, 4Q blew us all away with an amazing assembly all about the importance of teamwork. All of the children did a superb job, saying their parts without scripts and delivering it so clearly and confidently. There was also a fantastic video at the end.
