Standards of dress and appearance are expected to be smart and conventional. Shoes should be plain black, smooth-soled, and low heeled and of a conventional type and style. No soft top trainer type shoes are allowed. Boys' hair must be conventional in style and length: it should be above the collar and not a "number one" cut. Girls' hair, if shoulder length, must be tied back and ribbons must be either red or black. Jewellery, makeup and nail varnish are NOT allowed. A single pair of plain gold studs, one worn in each ear lobe, are the only earrings allowed. Of course pupils are encouraged to wear an inexpensive watch.
