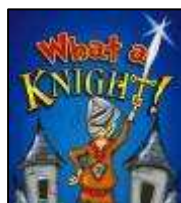

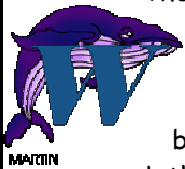

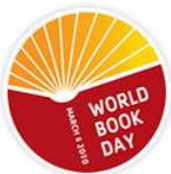
IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR NURSERY PARENTS
