96% of children said they were happy about their health over the last year.

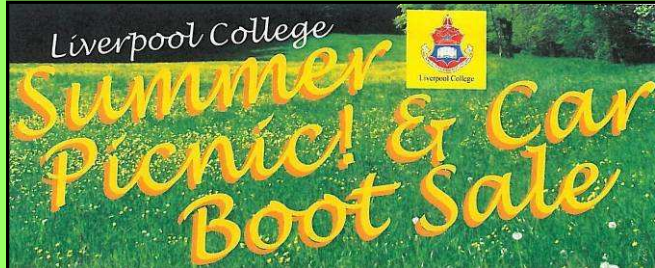
91% of children frequently enjoy their lessons.
