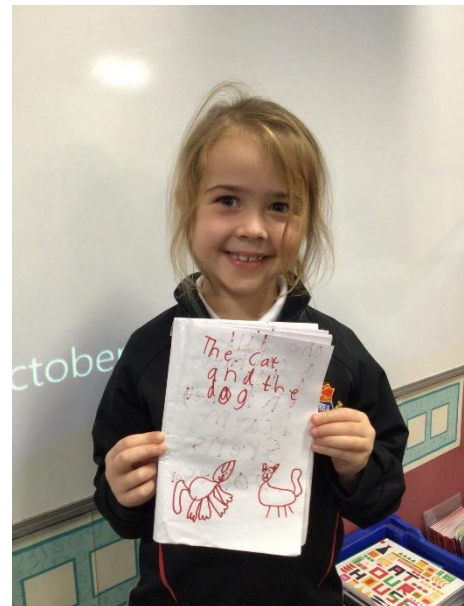

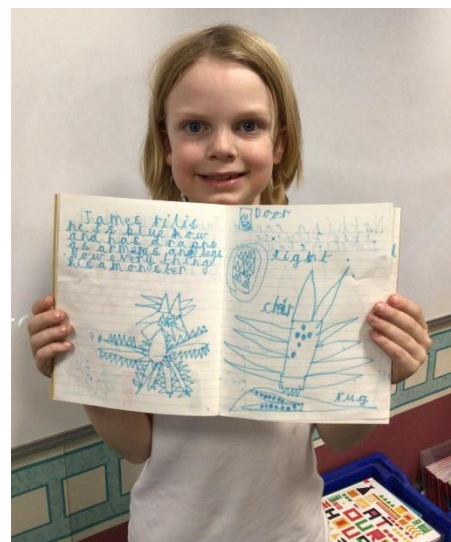

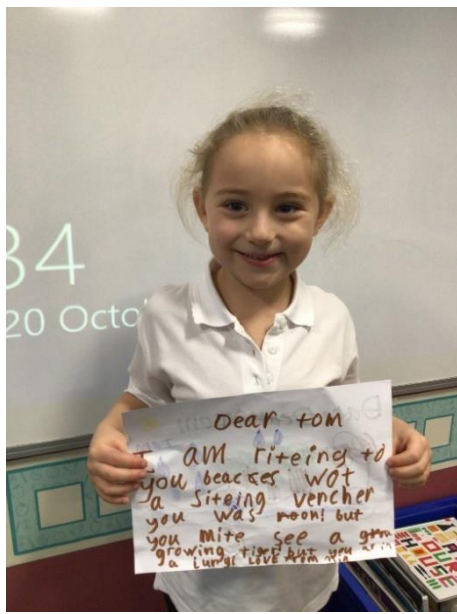


Well done to Esme 2Q who wrote a story at home and read it out to class confidently

Chapter 1

Chapter 1 have been looking at Diwali this week. We talked about the celebrations and listened to some stories. We have also watch the video 'For the Birds' and use this as a stimulus for opening up a discussion about bullying and treating others unkindly in preparation for Anti-Bully week next week. Chapter 2

Chapter 2 have continued their Puzzles sessions this week by practising their wordsearch skills. We thought about tips and tricks that can help us spot words efficiently, such as looking for special friends (digraphs) or initial sounds. Some children even had a go at creating their own wordsearches!

This week, we've been rehearsing songs for Young Voices. This is an exciting, huge multi-school singing event in Manchester that we will be taking part in!

We've also entered a sketching competition to win personalised stationary and Disney workshops for the school.

Chapter 4

In 'Music in the Morning', we moved on to learning 'Twinkle Twinkle', which involved more notes than last week. Mayibo B (4P) blew us all away with his solo performance; he didn't even need to look at the screen! In 'Dance Fitness', we did quite a rigorous workout to some of the songs from High School Musical. We are looking forward to part two next week! In 'Make & Sell', we have been carrying out Market Research. We discussed the importance of this in the design process, making sure the products we sell reflect what our customers actually want. We spent some time creating surveys, and have since used break and lunch times to ask our target markets all about their preferences! Also, in 'Time to Shine' this week, Areej H (4P) delivered a really special recital of a part of the Quran, which we were all captivated by!

Whole School

This week, we were treated to a fantastic assembly all about Divali, led by some students from the upper school during Reflection. We learnt about the origins of the festival, and how and why it is celebrated around the world today.

Chapter 5

This week in Chapter 5, we warmed up our brains by following and participating in our next Brain Gym activity - coordination and rhythm was key for this session! We also continued with our First Aid course, thinking about what shock is in relation to bleeding. Our exercise game of the week in Fitness Games required us to roll a dice to see how many of each exercise we would do!



Chapter 6

This week in LC+ Chapter 6 the children have been learning their Spanish poetry ready for the Christingle service. 6Q completed their dancing block having learned and performed a choreographed routine. They will now be moving onto swimming for the remainder of this term. 6R have also completed their restorative thinking block. Along with 6P, they will now start putting this learning into practice to help their peers and other members of the school.

6P have now completed their block of swimming.

With the completion of some of these areas of LC+, newer activities will be starting up. A selection of children from across the classes will be continuing dancing and learning a new routine to perform as part of a production at the end of the year. Other children will be learning the different skills associated with Japanese Manga drawing. Finally the whole year group are going to be spending some time working on mindfulness.

Sports Report

I'm afraid the weather has tested us several times recently, absolutely decimating our planned sports program. This week, we were due to have a Year 3 match vs St.

Oswald's on Tuesday, a Year 5 & 6 Girls' football match against LIPA, and on Thursday our Year 5 girls' footballers were due to play Gilmour, but all were called off. We are hoping for a break in the weather to allow our fields to recover, as we have lots of children desperate to play!!

The Y6 netball team completed their mini league yesterday. They have all played brilliantly over the past few weeks and have improved as a team and individually. All of the girls should be so proud of themselves as they have showed great sportsmanship and respect while playing. We hope to continue this mini league with the Year 5 team after February half term. Well done to everyone who played!

The Y6 Netball team played against a well drilled Birkenhead team. There was some excellent defending from Layla S, super mid court play from Jasmine O-M and great attacking from Eva H. Cassia O played magnificently in the mid court and Orla B intercepted so many passes! It gave our girls a good taste of high level netball and they all really enjoyed it.
