Some parents have added themselves to their child's class using a separate account. This then shows them as a student in class and interferes with the class lists and statistics. If parents are checking Seesaw for their child then please do so via the child's account only as any accounts not belonging to a child in the class will be deleted. Can all parents also check that their child is in the correct class as some have used a code from a different class. If your child is registered in the wrong class you will need to add them to their correct one using the code issued for their class. Equip are back and working with different bubbles at lunch time as well as offering an afterschool activity.




When dropping off & picking up children from school:


