Thank you to all of our catering staff for their hard work this term. We




will invite a few more parents during the summer term to sample the school lunches.

FOREST SCHOOL

We did say that the weather would not deter us, and so today it was proven....we were knee deep in mud and thoroughly soaked!!

Both groups joined Mr Stamper and Mrs Shackell in the Dell for a litter picking exercise. The children were so excited to explore the woodland area and collect some of the junk cast away down there at the same time, they can really multi-task!!

We provided bin bags and rubber gloves and we "Wombed" our way through the grassy knolls and mud piles disposing of useless articles and stock piling others that may be of use in our Forest School setting. We found an old metal chair frame which may be useful for cooking, a big plastic box for storage, some billy cans (finders keepers!!) and a number of empty discarded hanging baskets which the children can decorate and fill for a splash of floral extravagance...."making good use of the things that we find, things that the everyday folk leave behind!" We located some fragrant wild garlic and even an



expired bank card!! Sadly, we also found A LOT of litter, 10 filled bin bags in total.

Despite the lashing rain, the children had enormous fun, but as you can see from the pics below, good outdoor clothing is absolutely necessary.



Some of the children didn't have an outdoor coat at all and a number of them wore school shoes or expensive trainers. Christine was a model forester dressed in a waterproof coat, waterproof trousers and fabulous welly-type boots of beautiful pink....she looked sensible yet glamorous!! We do apologise if your child got wet but we are committed to Outdoor Learning regardless of the weather. Mrs Pease did her best with dry clothes from lost property and you may find some of your kids came home in slightly larger clothes than they arrived in.

Going forward, if the weather is wet or cold, the children won't be allowed to join in unless they have a waterproof coat on...school coat is sufficient for this.
