Wow!! I am totally in awe of our year 6 and 5 children who, on Tuesday, worked together to reconstruct our

outdoor classroom in time for our pre-prep children to enjoy!

The windy weather of Monday night literally, brought the house down. The tarpaulin roof was wrestled from its binds and was a mangled wreck when we arrived on Tuesday. 6P thoughtfully considered the issue. Between us, we decided that the best option was to lower the whole roof, unthread it, re-position it and re-hoist it...it was as complicated as it sounds!!
