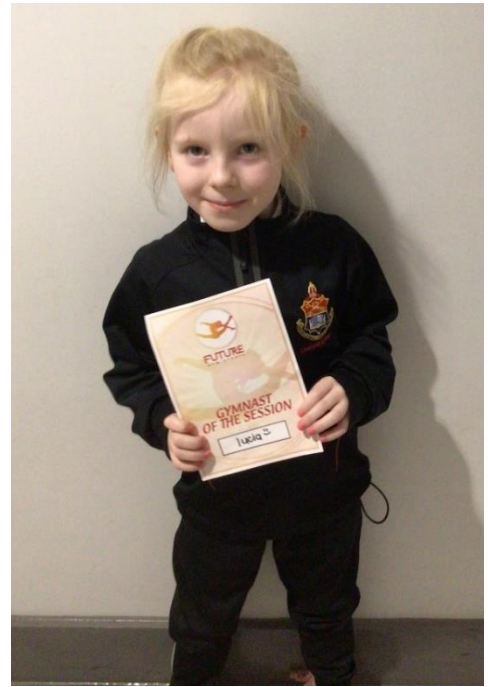
Mini Vinnies News
