Dear Parents and Carers

A brief message today at the end of a short first week back, after what I hope was a relaxing break for the students.

This week I have had to speak to too many students about their rather blasé attitude to wearing face coverings which are required by current government guidance. I would welcome your support in reminding students that wearing a covering when going into a school building is no different to the basic expectation that a covering is worn when entering a shop. Sadly, the attitude of some students when reminded has been poor and we will not accept rudeness to staff who are simply asking students to follow the procedures that the government has set out.

From Monday, wearing of a face covering will be mandatory in the House Space communal areas. To assist with social distancing, year 12 will have access to three House spaces - Brook's, Butler's and Selwyn's.

On a more positive note, I have copied an email that the school received over half-term which was nice to read.
