
In OPAL play, the mud kitchen is an engaging, open-ended space where children mix, create, and experiment using natural materials like soil, water, leaves, and stones. It supports imaginative play, problem-solving, collaboration, and sensory exploration. The children are loving the mud kitchen and have created all kinds of mud soups and meals.

In School, On Time, Everyday!

Regularly arriving late to school is unsettling for your child and can have a negative impact on their engagement in school life.

Arriving late means they often miss important information, including the plan for the day or the beginning of their first lesson. Therefore, they may miss key learning that hinders them to follow the rest of the lesson, affecting comprehension and retention of key information.

Pupils can come into school from 8:15am and the school day starts promptly at 8:25am. If a child arrives at school after 8:25am without prior arrangements having been agreed, they will be deemed late. **The school gates closes at 8:35am** and registers close at 8:30am. Arrival at school after this time, without prior approval, will be recorded as late. If your child arrives very late, this may be recorded as an unauthorised absence for the whole morning.

Dear Parents/Carers,

Times table recall is recognised as essential to understand many maths concepts. To encourage practice of recalling the times tables, we have signed up to a times table competition called the "MTC Cup"

What is it: MTC Cup - a country-wide competition, with lots of local school competing

Where: Emile app and website

When: 9 am on Wednesday the 22nd January - 3pm on Thursday 23rd January

During this time, we are able to compete against a number of local schools and hope that your child can help us win and may be qualify for the national finals! We will be trying to access this in school where possible but our main opportunity is for the children to access it online as part of their homework for this week.

The competition is based on the use of an online app called "Learning with Emile". The app is free from the Google Play Store, Apple Store and Microsoft Store. There is also a web- based version that can be found <https://web.emile-education.com/>.

We currently use Emile for our spellings so the children can use their usual login to access the game. The logins are stuck in the front of their homework book!

Every correct answer given by your child in an "MTC game" **between 6am and 8pm** contributes to our school's score.

It is worth noting that there are only certain game types that allow students to score points for the world cup. Namely those MTC style games that cover all the times tables 2-12 with 6 seconds to answer (indicated with a football icon).
