## **Advance notice of early school finish time on Friday 23rd May 2025**

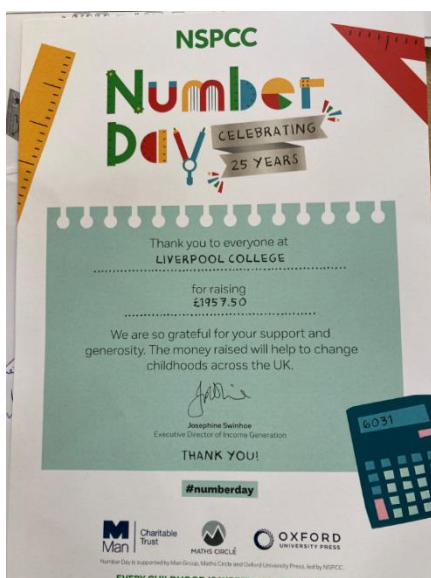
As you may already be aware, on Friday 23rd May 2025, Sefton Park will be hosting Radio 1's Big Weekend event.

3. Write a 500-word story to fill the pages

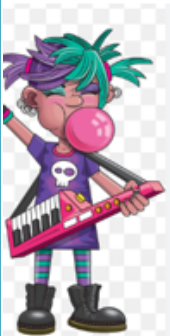
