The winners of the competition were: Robin R, Artie H, Stanley H, Aya M, Safa K, Lillia R and Jonah F.



Grab a drink, put your feet up, get comfy, and allow me to extol the virtues of our incredible Year 5 and 6 cricket team. On Thursday we walked to Sefton Park cricket club under the first clouds seen over South Liverpool in weeks (typical) ready for the annual Dynamo cricket tournament.

We warmed up and got ourselves ready to go. The schedule gave us our 5 group games all in a row, with no breaks, but that didn't deter us. What followed was breathtaking. Each game saw us post staggering scores (our biggest win was 198 - 25), as we ran out group winners with 5 wins from 5. Lister awaited us in the final after winning their group. We possibly saved our best, most polished performance for the final, winning by 164 runs to 38.
