Sporting Club Merseyside will continue their offering of after-school football at Liverpool College into the 2025/26 school year. From September 2025, Years 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 will continue to train on Wednesdays.

All training sessions are given by FA-Licensed Coaches who are highly experienced with coaching kids. The training sessions are designed and monitored by a UEFA Pro-Licence coach. The main focus of the training sessions will be the children's enjoyment and the sessions are given in a supportive and positive environment, and in a fun way.
