Championships in March! We are very proud of them - good luck guys!





# In School, On Time, Everyday!

Regularly arriving late to school is unsettling for your child and can have a negative impact on their engagement in school life.

Arriving late means they often miss important information, including the plan for the day or the beginning of their first lesson. Therefore, they may miss key learning that hinders them to follow the rest of the lesson, affecting comprehension and retention of key information.

**Pupils can come into school from 8:15am and the school day starts promptly at 8:25am.** If a child arrives at school after 8:25am without prior arrangements having been agreed, they will be deemed late. **The school gates closes at 8:35am** and registers close at 8:30am. Arrival at school after this time, without prior approval, will be recorded as late. If your child arrives very late, this may be recorded as an unauthorised absence for the whole morning.
