### **NUT ALLERGY INFORMATION**

- There are a number of Prep pupils with nut allergies. This can be mild or quite severe - even to the point of merely touching a nut or breathing the air around one can cause a problem for a child.
- Can I ask parents to ensure that, as far as possible, the snack that they give their child for school does not contain nuts. We have asked all staff/children in the Prep school to be vigilant about this.
- If your child has a nut allergy and requires piriton or an epipen, please ensure that both of these medications are in school and up to date. Thank you for your co-operation.

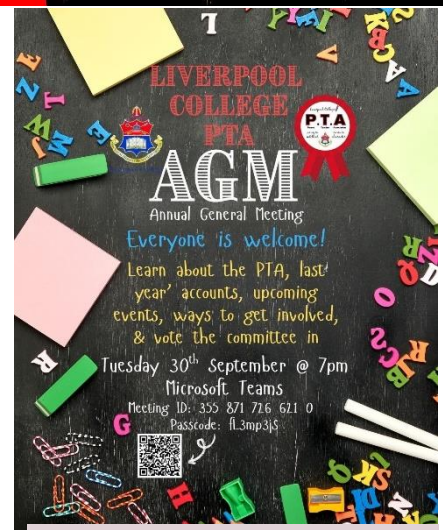
