Dear families

The government have today published final decisions on the consultation released in the summer about plans for assessment in 2022.

A key summary would be:

- Exams will be happening in a normal timetable in May and June. A draft version has been published and I will share with you as soon as it is finalised.
- 
- The structure of the exams will be the same - number of papers, length and type of questions.
- 
- The exam boards will provide advance information about the focus of the content of the exams for all A level subjects and the advance information will be provided by **7 February 2022** at the latest. We have no idea what this advanced information will look like, but the students have told me that they are pleased with this news.
- 
- This information relates to A levels and not BTECs and at the moment there is no update on BTEC assessment in 2022.
