

## THE COLLEGE GRACE

The Grace consists of three verses taken from different psalms. When used at the College, the verses were read by a prefect from an engraved plaque made from fragments of German bombs, which fell on the school during the war.

Oculi omnium in te sperant, Domine,  
et tu das escam illorum in tempore opportuno.

Tui sunt caeli et tua est terra,  
orbem terrae et plenitudinem eius, tu fundasti.

Confitemini Domino quoniam bonus,  
quoniam in aeternum misericordia eius.
