

FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) - Homework

What is my role in homework?

Encouragement is a significant role. Ensure that your child manages and copes with the workload. Sit with them. Talk to them about the tasks. If youngsters verbalise their learning, they are more likely to retain the knowledge.

I am busy and do not have time to help. What can I do?

It is not essential that you sit with them and work alongside them, but showing an interest is imperative. Ask them what tasks they are undertaking tonight and sound enthusiastic!

How much homework should my child be doing?
