Please see below the list of PE kit and Games kit and a photograph of correct kit.

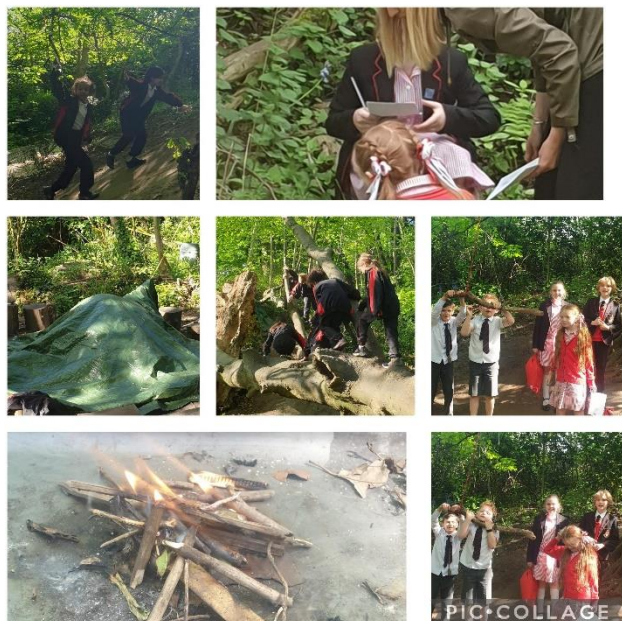
PE Kit

Full school tracksuit, white polo t-shirt, black skort or black shorts, white socks, trainers, black pumps for gymnastics.

Games Kit

Uniform C - Full school tracksuit, white polo t-shirt, black skort, , white socks for netball, trainers, red and black school socks, mouthguard and shin pads for hockey.
